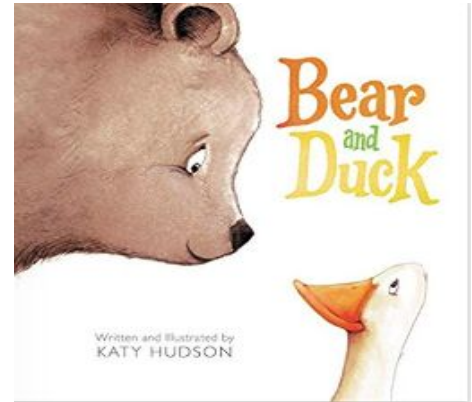


Bear and Duck: Major Events

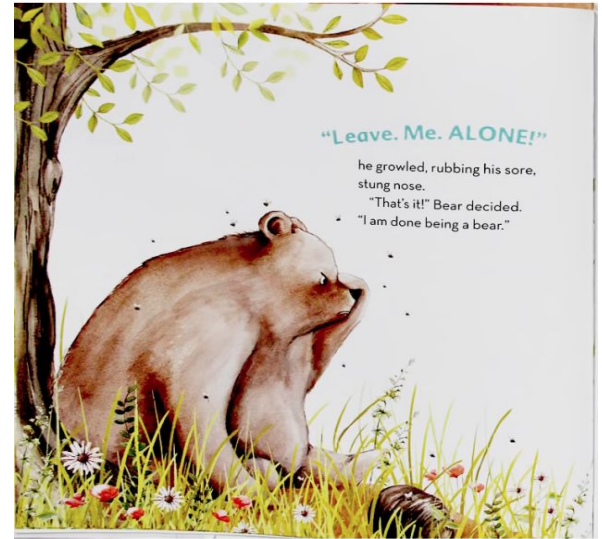
The **major events** from a story are the most important things that happen in the **beginning, middle,** and **end.**

Let's choose the **major events**
from the **beginning, middle,**
and **end** of this story.



The most important (**major**)
event from the **beginning** is:

- B. Bear decides he doesn't want to be a bear anymore.



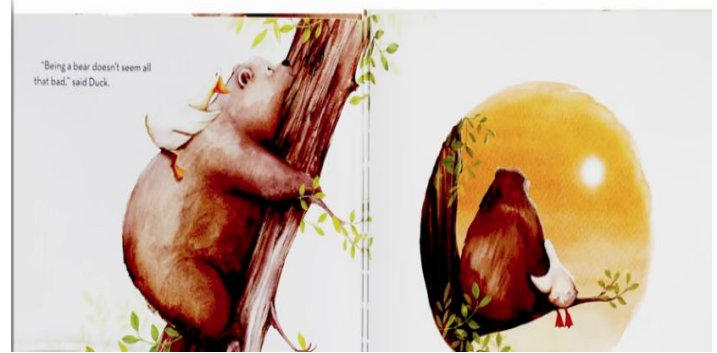
The most important (**major**) event from the **middle** is:
