

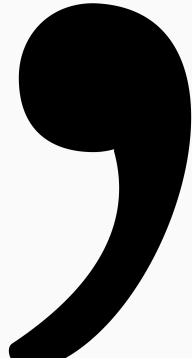
Contractions



What is a contraction?

A contraction is a shorter word for two words that are put together.

An **apostrophe** replaces the missing letters in the new word.



A shorter way of saying:

I am = I'm

A shorter way of saying:

we will = we'll

A shorter way of saying:

he is= he's

A shorter way of saying:

is not=isn't

A shorter way of saying :

are not= aren't

A shorter way of saying:

we are=**we're**

A shorter way of saying:

was not=**wasn't**

A shorter way of saying:

I will = I'll

A shorter way of saying:

she is = she's

A shorter way of saying:

have not=**haven't**
