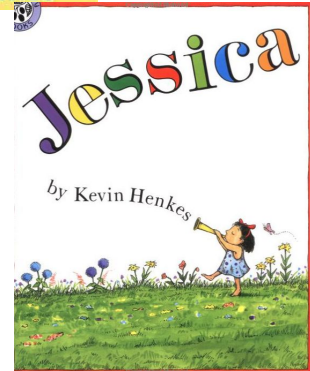
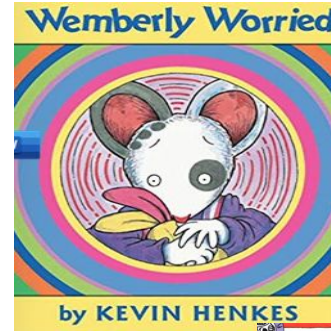
**What** did Wemberly worry about?
