Character Chain—A character chain is created by using words to describe a character that connect by each new word beginning with the last letter of the previous word. You may need to use synonyms for some of the attributes/traits. You may include both positive and negative traits, but they need to make sense for the character based on his actions in the play thus far. Do not repeat words. Be sure to spell correctly. A misspelled word can ruin the entire chain!

Sample: Fruit

Banana Apricot Tangerine Elderberry
