Paleolithic Age:

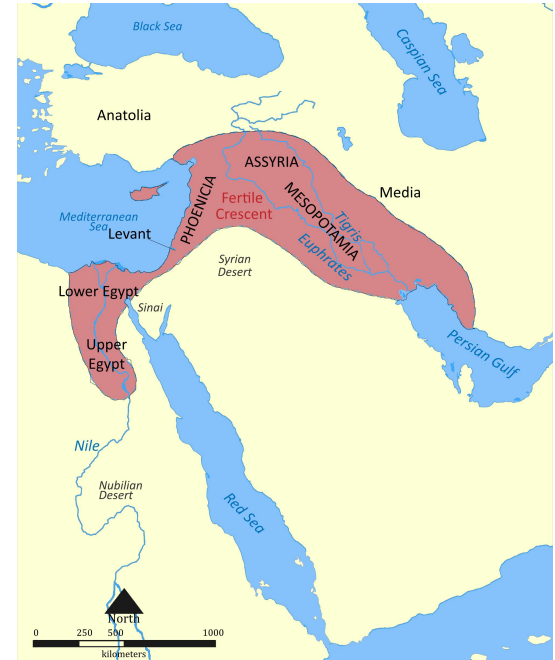
The first period of the Stone Age, called the Old Stone Age, from about 2 million years ago to around 8000 BCE

The later part of the Stone Age, called the New Stone Age, lasted from about 8000 BCE to 3000 BCE

Fertile Crescent:

An arch-shaped region
with rich soil, located in
Southwest Asia



Catal Hoyuk:

A Neolithic town discovered in
central Turkey



Domesticate:

To train a wild animal to be useful to
humans
