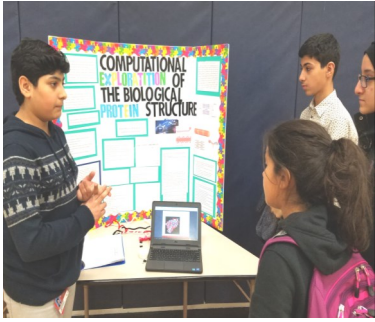
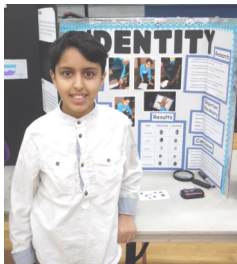


2017 SALINA SCIENCE FAIR
