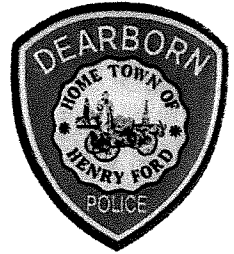

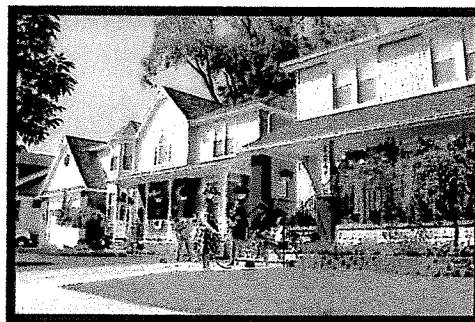
Crime Prevention Awareness

These Crime Prevention Tips may reduce the risk of becoming a victim of crime.

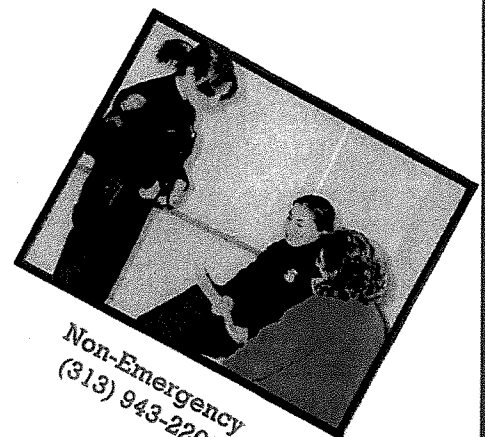
- ✓ Report all suspicious activity anonymously to (313) 943-3030.
- ✓ Become involved in your community, participate in Neighborhood Watch.
- ✓ Use Operation Identification to protect your valuables. The Crime Prevention Unit has kits available at the police department for residents.
- ✓ Go to www.dearbornpolice.com and visit the Dearborn Police Department's Crime Prevention website.
- ✓ Contact a Crime Prevention Officer to schedule a Crime Prevention meeting for your group or association (313) 943-3092.
- ✓ Get to know your neighbors. Join your Neighborhood Association.
- ✓ Protect **YOURSELF**:
 - Be aware of your surroundings.
 - Trust your instincts.
 - Carry only what you need.
 - Walk in well-lit areas.
- ✓ Protect your **VEHICLE**:
 - Keep your doors locked at all times.
 - Do not leave your vehicle running unattended.
 - Remove any valuables from the vehicle:
 - ♦ GPS units, laptop computers, purses, money, etc.
 - Park your vehicle in a safe place:
 - ♦ In your driveway or garage
 - ♦ In a well-lit area
 - Use wheel locks, steering column locks & alarm systems.
- ✓ Secure & Protect your **HOME**:
 - Keep your doors & windows locked at all times.
 - Trim bushes and landscaping around the house.
 - Use proper exterior lighting.
 - Use light timers when on vacation.
 - Keep your garage door closed and locked.
 - Enroll in the Vacation House Check Program when on vacation (313) 943-2241.

On-Line Reporting

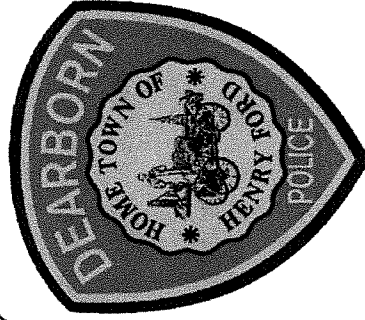
As the Dearborn Police Department continues its technology upgrade to provide better service, we are proud to introduce On-Line Reporting. The On-Line Reporting System allows citizens to report minor incidents, along with anonymous TIPS from any computer with internet access. Citizens can report non-critical incidents without waiting for an officer to respond and allow patrol officers more time to address community concerns.

Using the On-Line Reporting System is simple. On the City's web page at cityofdearborn.org, click the "On-Line Reporting" link under public safety, or simply go to the police home page. Once you submit the report it will be reviewed by a Police Supervisor. You will then receive a copy of your report, via email at no charge. The On-Line Reporting System is only available for incidents that occurred within the City of Dearborn. If for some reason the report does not contain adequate information, you will also receive an email requesting clarification.

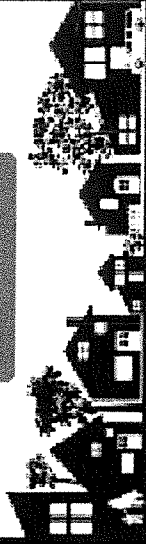
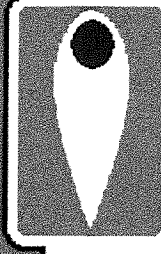

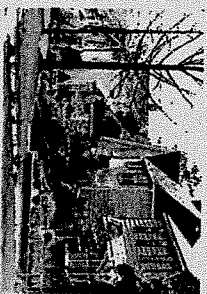
Neighborhood Watch

The City of Dearborn has initiated a Neighborhood Watch Program. Neighborhood Watch is a community crime prevention program, which enlists the active participation of citizens in cooperation with the Police Department. Its purpose is to reduce crime, create an alert neighborhood, and facilitate the reporting of suspicious activity. It also includes hosting crime prevention meetings to teach residents crime prevention techniques.

The City of Dearborn and the Police Department understand that active participation of neighborhood residents is a critical element of community safety. Participation consists of a willingness to look out for suspicious activity in neighborhoods and reporting it to law enforcement. The Police Department has implemented a Neighborhood Watch Line to assist participation; therefore to report SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY CALL (313) 943-3030.

It is important to distinguish between activities that are considered *EMERGENCIES* and those that are considered suspicious. An *EMERGENCY* is any event that requires *immediate* POLICE, FIRE or MEDICAL response. In the event of an EMERGENCY CALL 911 immediately.

For general information regarding the police department citizens should call (313) 943-2240.



SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY

The City of Dearborn's Neighborhood Watch telephone line should be called to report any suspicious activity that is occurring or has occurred. Citizens are requested to contact **(313) 943-3030** when a suspicious occurrence is observed, any time of day.

Residents should remain alert to anything that seems slightly "out of place" or is occurring at an unusual time of day. Residents should contact police immediately and do not worry about being embarrassed if your suspicions are determined to be unfounded. Please remember, **DO NOT ATTEMPT TO APPREHEND A PERSON COMMITTING A CRIME OR INVESTIGATE A SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITY.**

The following **MAY** indicate possible suspicious/criminal activity:

- Open or broken windows at a closed business or unoccupied residence.
- Unusual noises or dogs barking continuously.
- The sound of breaking glass.
- Persons running, especially if carrying something of value at an unusual hour or not appropriately dressed for exercise.
- Heavy traffic to and from a home occurring on a daily basis.
- Loitering around or peering into cars either parked in the driveway, on the street or in a parking lot.
- Slow moving vehicles, with or without lights activated with no obvious destination.
- Parked vehicles, either unoccupied or occupied by one or more persons, especially at an unusual hour.
- Persons detaching mechanical parts or accessories from a vehicle.

Providing complete and accurate descriptions when reporting *emergency situations* or suspicious activity will greatly aid responding law enforcement personnel. Throughout your day, practice your observation skills to improve your recollection should you have to report an emergency or suspicious activity.

When describing events, write down the following as soon as possible:

- What happened?
- When it happened.
- Where it occurred.
- Were there any injuries?
- Were there any weapons?

When describing persons indicate:

- Race, gender and possible age.
- The subjects height and weight.
- The subjects hair color and/or facial hair.
- Clothing description.
- Direction of travel or method of escape.

When describing vehicles indicate:

- The license plate, state of origin, make, model and possible year of the vehicle.
- Any unusual characteristics with the vehicle.
- Direction of travel.
