## Arrival/Dismissal Procedures are the same as the school year:

- The main entrance doors will open at 8:00am for tutoring students ONLY.
- Breakfast will begin at 8:30am.
- Students should wait at their assigned areas once they are finished with breakfast or if they are not eating breakfast.
- Parents should not park along the yellow curb in front of the school in the AM. This is the bus lane only.
- Parents will pick up their students from the assigned areas outside between 3:25pm-3:30pm; if your child is a walker, please communicate this information with your child's teacher.
- Parents whose children attend PM tutoring should plan to pick up their child from outside of the main entrance at 4:00pm.
- Students left past 4:00pm more than 2x will be removed from the PM tutoring program (no exceptions).

## **Student Code of Conduct**

The Summer Discovery Program is only 5 weeks and includes an abbreviated daily schedule. Students involved in this program should maximize the summer learning opportunities that they are privileged to experience. In order to do so, students must adhere to the Core Values at ALL times, this is a non-negotiable. During our summer program, we do not have any support staff available to assist with excessive disciplinary issues and poor choices that disrupt learning or harm other students. These behaviors will not be tolerated. Students are expected to demonstrate safe choices, responsible behavior, and respect with regards to themselves, staff, and other students. Students struggling to demonstrate Core Values will be sent home for the day. We have an exciting and packed schedule throughout the summer and consequences will include the possibility of missing out on special events and activities. Please discuss with your child what honesty, respect, integrity, citizenship, and responsibility look like at all times, throughout the building, with adults and peers. We will be sending home a Behavior Contract for you to review with your child on the 1st day of Summer Discovery. We want this to be a safe, fun, and meaningful experience for all students! We appreciate your support and cooperation.
