










10 Ways to Make Your Name

1. WRITING IN SHAVING CREAM	Put shaving cream in a flat tray and make letters by using your finger(s).	
2. MAGNETIC LETTERS	Find the letters in your name and put them in the proper order.	
3. WIKKI STIX LETTERS	Bend into letters to practice letter formation and then run fingers over the letters for a multi-sensory experience.	
4. WRITING IN A SAND BOX	Put sand in a flat tray and make letters by using your finger(s).	
5. PLAY-DOUGH LETTERS	Roll play-dough snakes and shape them into letters. Start by writing the name on a piece of large white paper to help w/letter formation.	
6. STAMPING	Use the letter stamps to spell out your name and stamp them out on paper.	
7. CHEERIOS	Use individual pieces to form letters. Start by writing the name on a piece of large white paper to help w/letter formation.	
8. GLITTER GLUE	Write letters with the glitter glue on paper and let dry. Run fingers over the letters for a multi-sensory experience.	
9. SANDPAPER	On the back of a sheet of fine sandpaper trace the letters needed. Cut out and run fingers over and around the letters for a multi-sensory experience.	
10. COLLAGE	Make bubble letters for your name. Inside those letters use cut up newspaper/magazines, fabric, cotton balls, feathers, etc. to fill in the letters.
