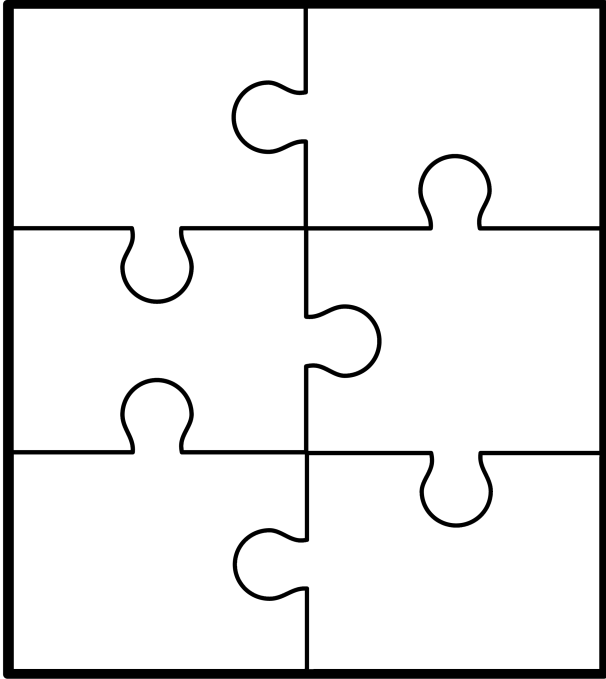

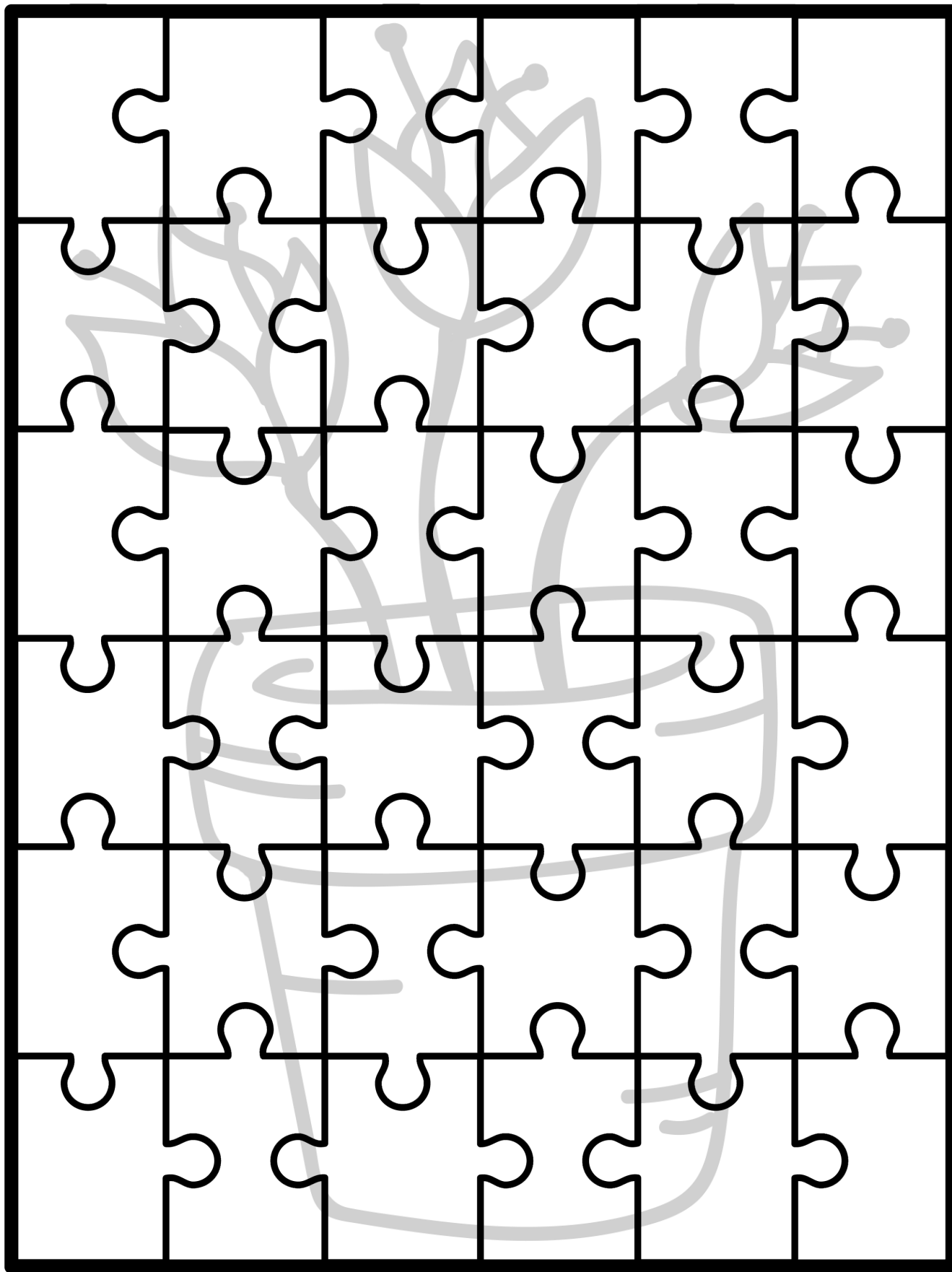
#### Steps for Your Puzzle:

1. Choose a puzzle layout from the options in this packet.
2. Color the gray lined image on the puzzle. Remember to trace the shapes before you color to promote staying inside the lines.
3. Cut on the black lines to create the puzzle pieces.
4. Put the puzzle back together. Time yourself to see how fast you can go!

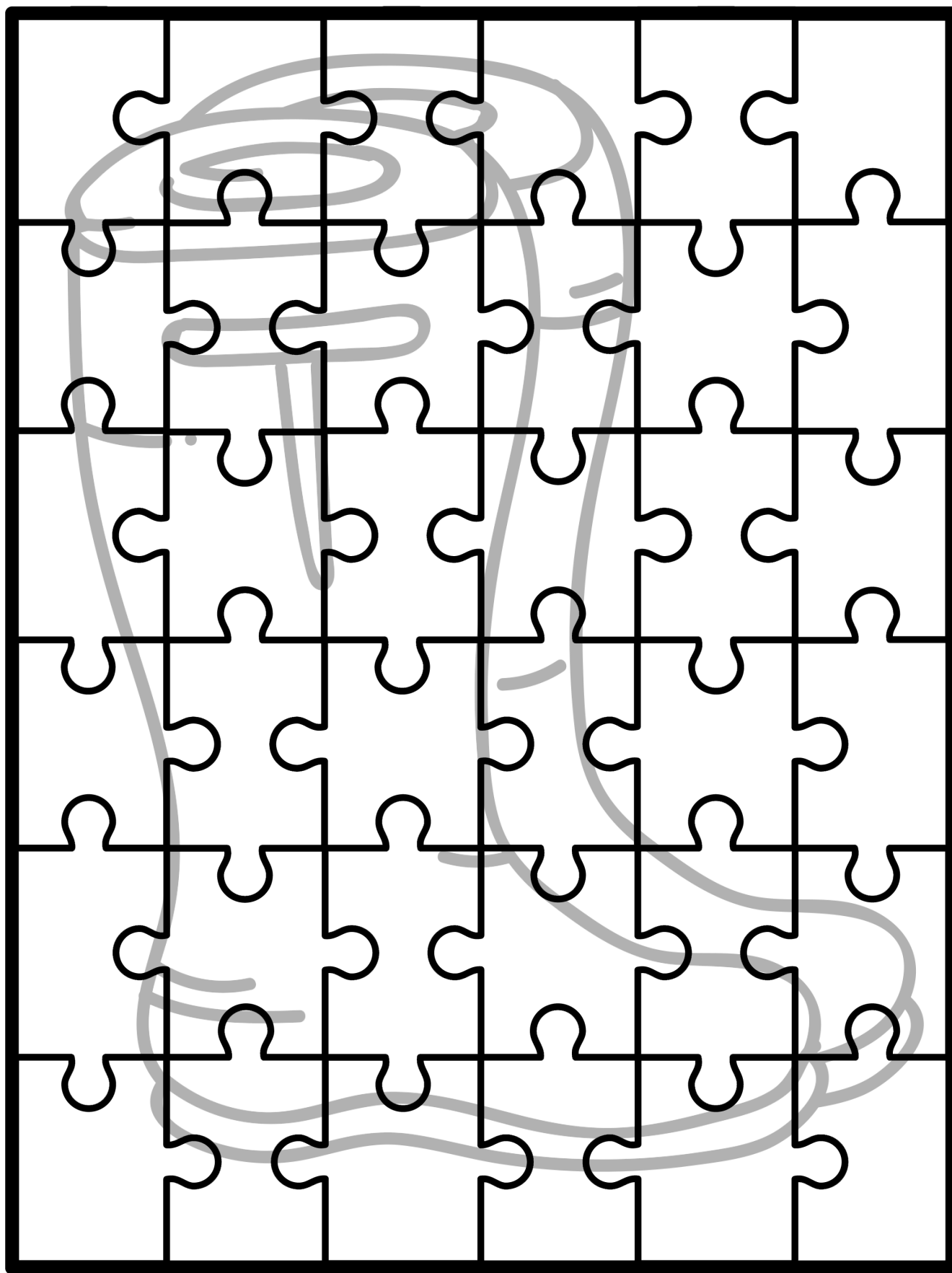
#### Ways to Incorporate Writing:

- Hide the pieces of the puzzle throughout your house. As your student finds each piece, have them write a letter on a separate sheet of paper or copy the word "puzzle"

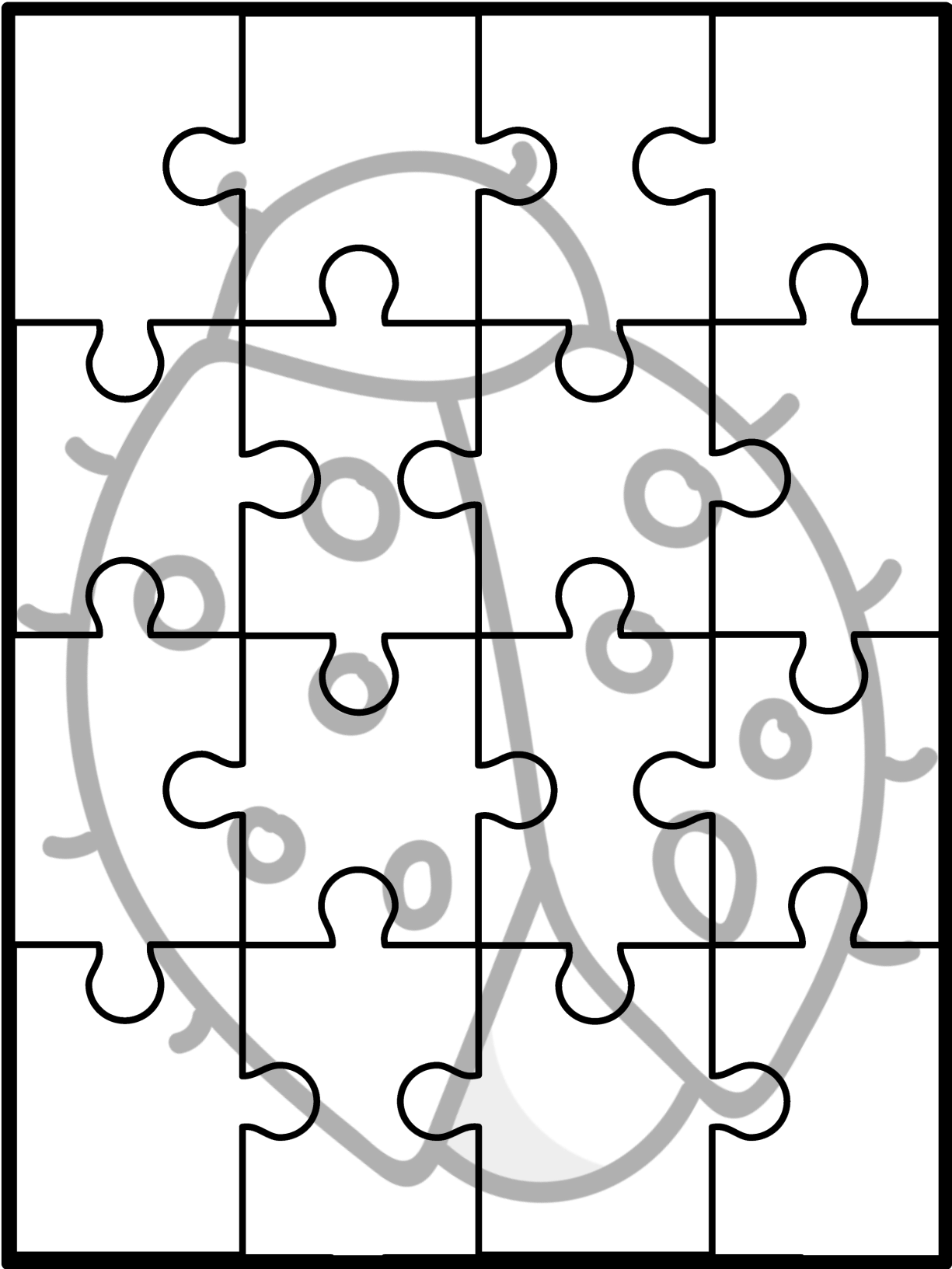
