

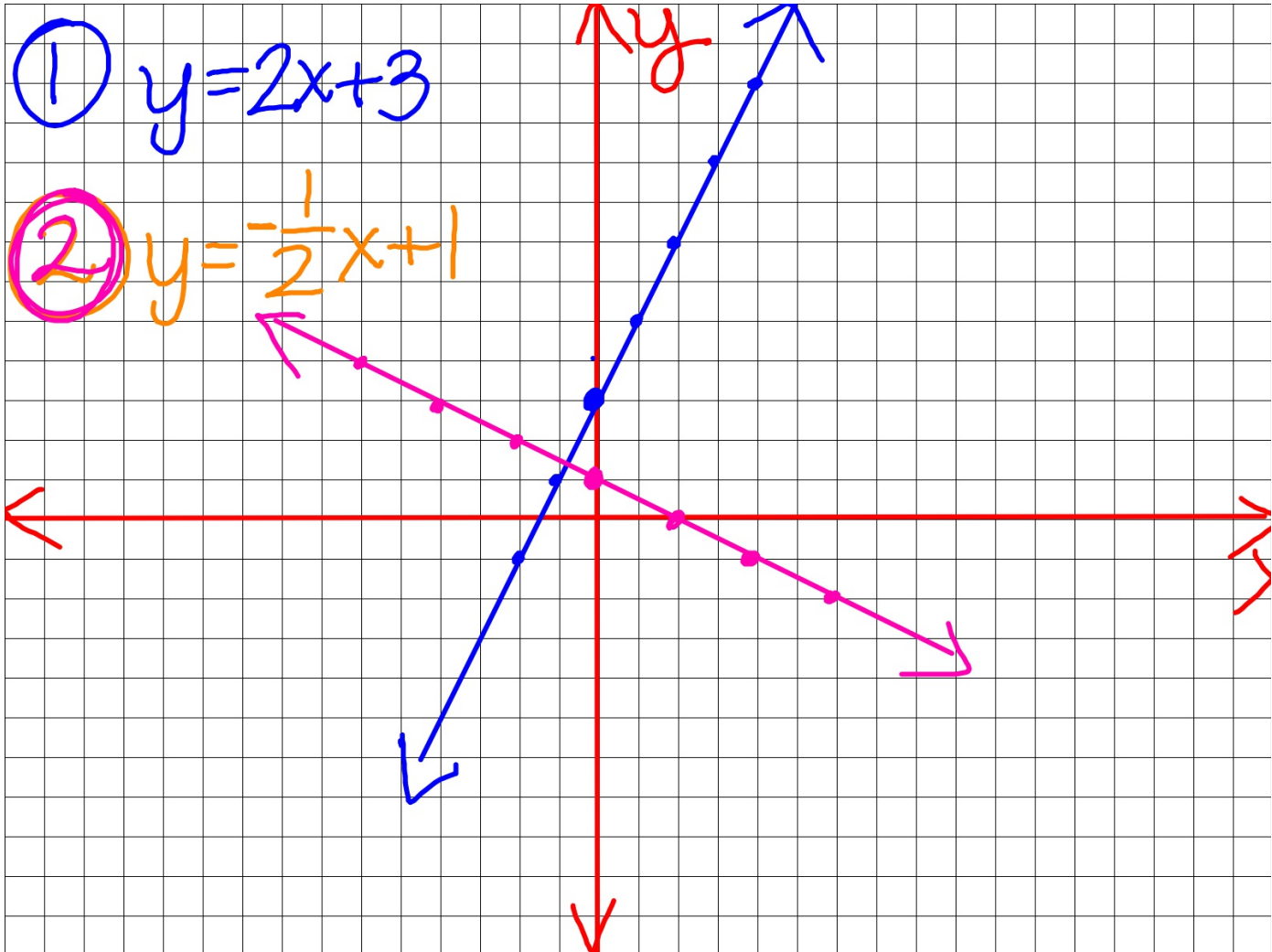
Slope-Intercept Form

$$y = mx + b$$

↓ ↘
Slope y-int

$\left(\frac{\text{rise}}{\text{run}}\right)$

1. Solve for y. Make sure equation is in slope-intercept form.
2. Plot the y-intercept. $(0, b)$
3. Use slope $\left(\frac{\text{rise}}{\text{run}}\right)$ to plot points.
4. Connect points and make your line.
