

Albert Pilot Bingo

Participants: This activity can be done individually or in groups of students.

Instructions: Print the Bingo board and distribute to students. During the duration of the pilot, have students track their progress using Albert Bingo. Offer your choice of incentives for Bingo, such as extra credit or even creating a class leaderboard.
