The AP Exam will be administered online and will be taken from your home. Tests will be 45 minutes long and will be made up of ONLY Free Response Questions (no multiple choice).

There will be two testing dates (so far we only know one will be in "early May" and one will be "later.")

CONTENT COVERED

Only Periods 1-7 will be on the exam



You will only be tested on Periods 1-7 (1491-1945). Beginning Wed, March 25th you can attend free, daily live AP review courses.

In order to give you a solid historical understanding of the United States, we will be learning an abbreviated version of 1945-present.
