





2020 CENSUS






The U.S. will have a census in 2020. The U.S. has a census every 10 years.

A census counts every person living in an area. The 2020 Census will count every person in the U.S.










A U.S. government group does the census. This group is called the Census Bureau.

The Census Bureau uses the census to gather information. The information is about people in the U.S.






The U.S. government uses the information.

The government decides how much money to give to states.






States use the money to build schools, hospitals, roads and more.







How does the Census Bureau do a census?

The Census Bureau sends census forms in March. They send a form to every home in the U.S.






Each form has a list of questions. The questions are about the people living in the home.








One question asks how many people live in the home.

Other questions ask for each person's name, birthday and age.





Everyone must answer the questions for the census. The census is a part of U.S. law.








People can answer the questions by mail, online or by phone.


Workers from the Census Bureau may visit some homes.






The workers ask questions. The workers count people living in the homes.
