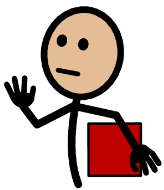

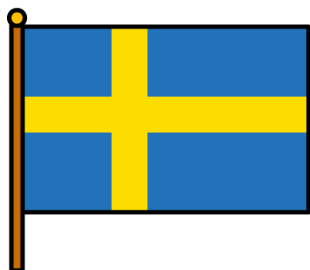

Earth is Greta Thunberg.

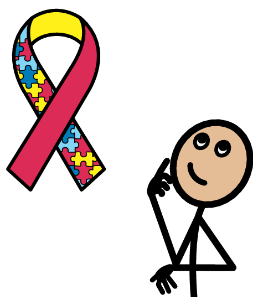




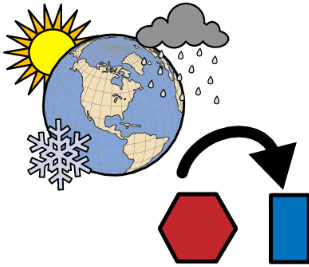
Greta was born in Sweden.

Many people think the climate is changing. They think climate change could be dangerous for Earth !

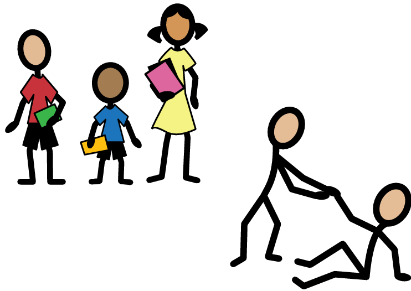


Climate change may bring floods, storms, wildfires and more.

Greta wants to help stop climate change.

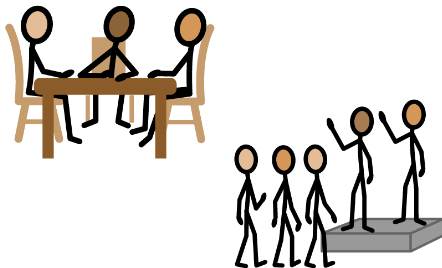


Greta wants government leaders to help too. She started protests in front of government buildings.

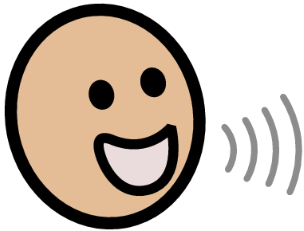


Students around the world heard about Greta. They wanted to help stop climate change.

Those students started to do protests too.

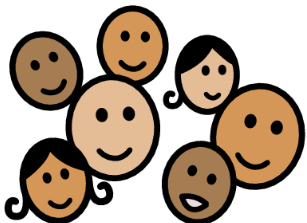
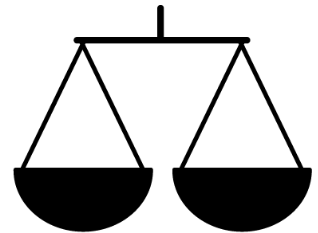


Greta started to meet with leaders. Now she meets with leaders around the world.

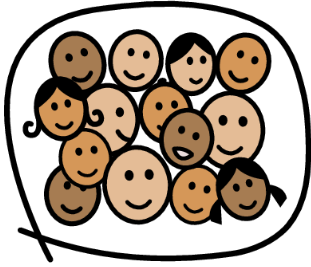


Greta talks to leaders about climate change. She talks about how leaders can protect Earth.

She wants the laws to protect Earth.**

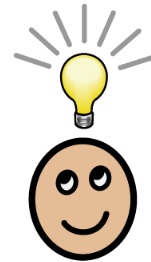

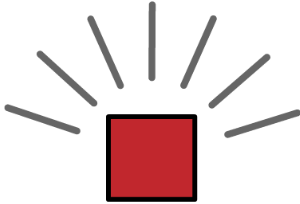
Greta thinks everyone can help.

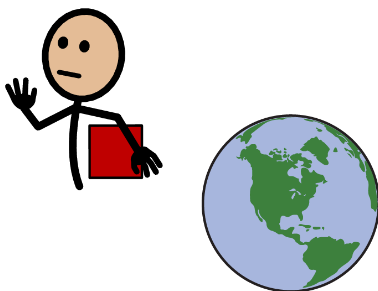
Greta asks people not to fly on planes. Planes can make pollution. Pollution can hurt Earth.

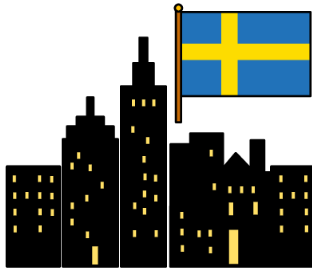

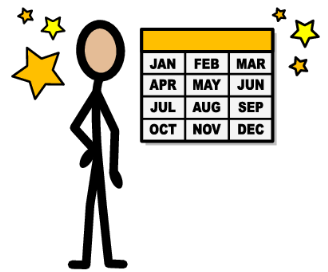


GRETA THUNBERG (2003 -)

Now Greta gives speeches around the world.

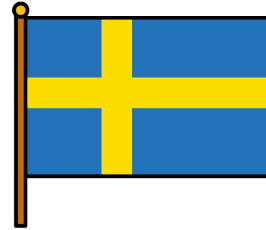

with cooking spray

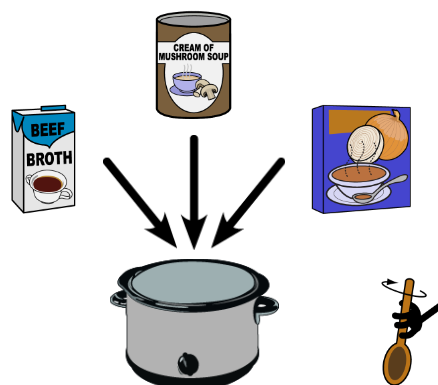

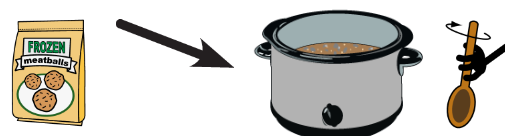

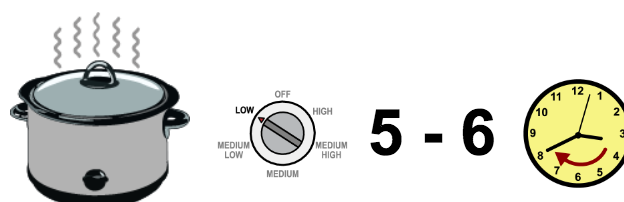
1. Put broth, canned soup and soup mix into slow cooker. Stir.

3. Cook on low 5 – 6 hours.

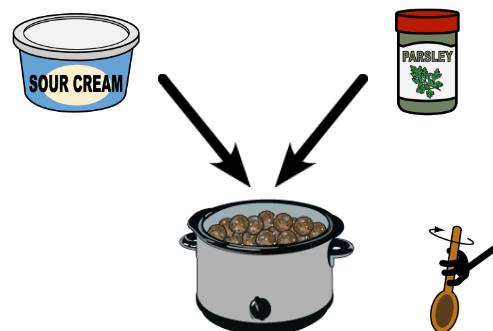

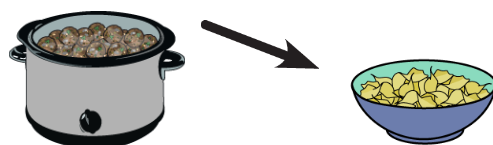
4. Put sour cream and parsley into slow cooker. Stir.
