

Complete Sentences

- Complete sentences must have a capital letter at the beginning. A capital letter is bigger than the rest.
- Complete sentences have more than five words.
- Complete sentences end with punctuation. Punctuation could be a question mark, exclamation point, or a period.

1. I asked my mom what will we eat today?
2. We are going to our cousin's house today!
3. I am going to sleep at nine o'clock.

- In complete sentences, there should not be capital letters unless there are proper nouns.
- * "I" by itself should ALWAYS be a capital.
- Complete sentences must MAKE SENSE! Read it out loud to make sure!
