About Your Spelling Words

Each syllable of a word should have only one vowel sound. Notice how the word below is divided into syllables.

cafeteria: caf-e-ter-i-a

- Syllables have only one vowel sound, but they can have one or more consonant sounds.
 In the word above, the syllables caf and ter have both a vowel and two consonant sounds.
- The first letter e, the letter i, and the letter a in cafeteria are syllables with only a vowel sound.
