

## For online learning, we'll have two types Synchronous Learning and Asynchronous Learning


Synchronous:

## **Asynchronous:**

Learning that takes place at the different times! Examples are independent assignments or group assignments


## For online learning, we'll have two types Synchronous Learning and Asynchronous Learning
