# Returned Papers

- On **Mondays** your student should bring home a stack of papers from the previous week.
- We typically check most of our assignments together as a class. Students are usually asked to check their own work, then I review the assignments.
- **Look for: “I need to practice”** on the top of your students paper to know what they should be working on at home.
- Students write the gradebook score on every assignment inside of a box at the top of the page.

- Papers that are checked, but do not have a gradebook score follow this grading system:

Star	Smile	OK	Practice	Incomplete
Student got the whole paper correct on his/her first try.	Student had some errors, but fixed them on his/her own.	Student had errors, but with teacher direction was able to fix them.	Student struggled, even with teacher assistance.	Student did not complete the assignment. Work needs to be completed & returned.

- Papers marked **“incomplete”** should be completed and turned in for a better grade.
- Papers with a **grade of 4** may be fixed and turned in for a better grade.
- **Spelling Word Work** comes home every Friday with their Word Work score, and test score written at the top.
  - Spelling tests are taken via Google Forms on Chromebooks.
