30 - Monday:

Do the following **iLearn** activity & study on **Quizlet** (at least 10 minutes daily)

- Click on “**Oktoberfest**” found on **iLearn**

If you do not remember how to get onto iLearn, see the bottom of this document for directions. You will read an article and answer 10 questions. I will post the assignment scores in GradeBook on Saturday. Click “Submit All & Finish” 2 times to submit the work and see your score. Feedback is provided at the end to see where to find the answer. You can redo the assignment multiple times. I will record your highest score.

- Click on “**Quizlet**” study sets (German greetings, numbers, days & months & colors) also found on **iLearn**
 - Start with Flashcards
 - Play 3 games of Match
 - See how you score on "Test"

01 - Wednesday

Do the following **iLearn** activity & study on **Quizlet** (at least 10 minutes daily)

- Click on “**Record a Video**” found on iLearn

Directions are found on iLearn. You will record a conversation in German. If you can find someone at home to speak with you in German, it will make it more fun! :) Include a greeting, ask about the name, ask about feelings & a state a goodbye. Check out a conversation I made with my son at home. Use page 1 from the German packet and Quizlet.com (German Greetings). On Quizlet, click on the speaker next to the words (under the flashcards to hear the pronunciation. I will use the rubric on iLearn to provide feedback. Those of you who want to ask additional questions from other pages in the German packet...go for it!!! If you do not have a camera on your computer, you can log

into iLearn on a phone & record a video into iLearn using a phone. Email me with questions.

03 - Friday

Have 2 different pages open on your computer today: **Google Classroom** & **Quizlet.LIVE**

Find the **code on Google Classroom** which will be posted **at 11am**. The **game will start at 11:08**. **Type the code from Google Classroom into Quizlet.live**. You will write your name on the screen. You will stare at 3 question marks on your screen until 11:08. Wait until 11:08. The screen will show who is on your team. Then an English word or phrase will appear on your screen. Only one of you on your team will have the right answer in German. When you see the word translated on your screen click on it. The game will end when the first team in your class answers the questions correctly & the fastest. I will post the winners under "comments" in Google Classroom.

Directions on how to get on iLearn to complete Monday's & Wednesday's work:

- Go to "**Dearbornschools.org**"
- Click on "**Student Portal**"
- Click on "**iLearn Classrooms**" (on top in the green/blue colored banner on top)
- Log on with your student "**log in**" information like you always do at school.

If you haven't done last weeks work, you have to do the following:

In the box: Enrollment Code...

type in the following code for your class

6s6gh2 (this is for A Day)

U2g7bq (this is for B Day)

Then the class will either appear on your screen or you have to **scroll down** and click on the following class: "**1st Hour Work (Explore Language)**"

Open the course and click on: "**Oktoberfest**" for Monday's assignment

Answer all the questions & don't forget to click "**Finish Attempt**" & "**Submit All & Finish**" (2 TIMES).

You will get a score after answering all questions.

You can retry to get a better score if you need to multiple times. I will record your highest score.

Then you will complete "**Record a Video**" for Wednesday's assignment
