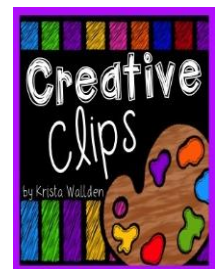
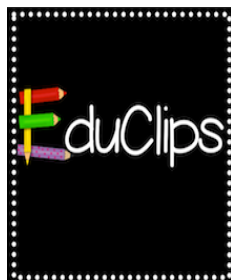

These books were designed to work in multi-age classrooms with students of varying abilities.

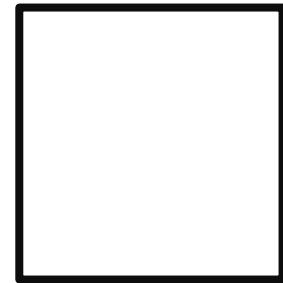
