

## Ancient Egypt & Language

Hieroglyph - writing system used by ancient Egyptians.

Rosetta Stone - Discovered in 1799 by French Expeditionary army and technical experts that found a slab of inscriptions. The inscriptions were in 3 languages. Able to decode Egyptian Hieroglyphs with Ancient Greek language. (way to translate into English).

1<sup>st</sup> Hieroglyphics used buildings and tombs. (Estimation that this began in 3000 BCE).

Not all symbols are letter-word sounds as some images = an entire word.  
Images don't have relation to the sound (ie: snake = J, but  = water)

Writers did not always use one or the other (phonogram = sound, ideogram = image)

so, no standard language or direction of print. (you know how to read it based on the direction the pictograms/iconograms point)

Only the wealthy were taught how to read and write (scribes)

Cartouche = a name tag (usually seen on tombs) You know it is a cartouche when it is surrounded by an oval →
