Over the last five months there have been two major factory accidents in Bangladesh that has cost the lives of more than 250 people.</p>
<p>#2 Bangladesh is so corrupt that officials are often bought off, allowing buildings like this to have illegal floors added</p>	<p>(D) Recently a factory manager in Bangladesh assured the worker that the cracked building was safe and sent them back in despite the workers concerns. Less than an hour later the building collapsed. Sadly, in Bangladesh officials are so corrupt that they can easily be bought off allowing unsafe buildings to be constructed.</p>

This will serve as your bridge between the evidence you choose and your claim</p> <p>#1 Due to the lack of laws that support workers rights people were afraid if they didn't return to work in an unsafe factory they would lose their jobs.</p>	<p>(B) We can clearly see that due to the lack of laws that support workers rights nothing could protect those who were afraid of losing their jobs if they did not re-enter the building. One of the main reasons that the textile industry flourishes in Bangladesh is that many safety regulations are ignored because bribery is an every day occurrence. This lack of accountability and corruption allows companies to take advantage of their workers and put their lives in danger.</p>
