Purpose:

- 1. To understand the text
- 2. To understand the historical context (when was this written, and why?)
- 3. To identify areas of interest and concern (what do I like/dislike about this?)

Strategies:

Underline/Circle/Highlight

- 1. The main idea/ author's purpose/ author's claim
- 2. People's names, names of places, dates (look up any name you don't recognize)
- 3. Vocabulary words/ unfamiliar words (look up anything you don't understand)
- 4. Important ideas and events

Write in the margins

- 1. Definition and identifications
- 2. How you feel about what you're reading (reactions)
- 3. Connections (how does this connect to you, or anything that you already know?)
- 4. Predictions (what do you think will happen next as a result of this?)
