### Napoleon (AF)



- One of the leaders after Old Major dies
- Kicks out Snowball
- Uses Squealer to persuade the animals
- Kills animals
- Has dogs he uses to threaten animals

### Joseph Stalin (RR)



- One of Bolshevik leaders after Lenin dies
- Chases Trotsky out of Russia to Mexico
- Relies heavily on propaganda
- Brutal dictator who killed thousands
- Uses KGB (secret police) to protect power

### Snowball (AF)



- One of the leaders after Old Major dies
- Leads the Battle of the Cowshed
- Give great speeches
- Chased out of the farm
- Supported building of the windmill

### Leon Trotksy (RR)



- One of leaders of Revolution after Lenin
- Master strategist and organizer
- Intellectual, eloquent speaker
- Exiled then killed by Stalin
- Supported rapid industrialization

## Squealer (AF)



- Worked to manipulate and persuade the animals using rhetoric
- Favored Napoleon and was more active after he took over the farm

## Propaganda (RR)



- Used to manipulate the Russian people
- Used heavily during Stalin's reign

### Mollie (AF)



- Pretty horse who loves her ribbons and sugar from humans
- Supports the rebellion but only half-heartedly
- Caught talking to humans from other farms
- Leaves the farm after rebellion

## Bourgeoisie – Upper Middle Class (RR)



- "Bougie" upper middle class who did not suffer like the working class
- Were living comfortably during the czar's reign, so were not as invested in the revolution as the proletariat

### Boxer, Clover (AF)



- Motto: "I will work harder"
- Literally a work house, does most of labor
- Supports rebellion
- Killed when questions Napoleon's rule

# Proletariat – Working Class (RR)



- Did all the manual labor, industrial work
- Marx believed that they would rise up against oppression
- Supported the revolution initially but later killed among thousands during Stalin's "Reign of Terror"

#### Mr. Jones (AF)



- Owner of Manor Farm
- Mistreats animals
- Alcoholic, takes poor care of animals
- Kicked out of the farm by animals

#### Czar Nicholas II (RR)



- Ruler of Russia
- People underfed; army lacked weapons supplies
- Bad leader
- Overthrown by Bolsheviks

## Dogs (AF)



- Raised by Napoleon, loyal to him
- Used to threaten and control animals

## KGB (RR)



- Stalin's secret police
- Used to maintain his power and keep the population under control

- Snowball wanted the animals to work hard to build this
- Napoleon did not, then later took credit for it

## Industrialization (RR)



- Trotsky was in favor of rapid industrialization to develop the economy
- Stalin was not

## Old Major (AF)



- One of oldest animals on the farm, respected
- Lays the foundation for Animalism in his speech
- Dies before the rebellion takes place
- His skull is preserved

## Karl Marx/Vladimir Lenin (RR)





- Karl Marx developed the communist ideology
- Vladimir Lenin was the founder and leader of the Bolshevik Revolution
- He dies and is succeeded by Trotsky and Stalin
- His body is embalmed and displayed



- Went hungry again under Napoleon's
- Many killed by Napoleon


# Peasants – Working Class (RR)
