- 500-word limit

- Neat and legible handwriting or student-typed entries only
- Include a title
- Do not put the student's name on the entry. A second sheet must be submitted with the following information:
 Name, Grade Level, Teacher's Name
 Title of Contest Entry

Awards will be given to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners for each of the grades along with one grand prize winner. Students who win an award will be invited to read their entries at the March 8th Leadership Day.

Late entries cannot be accepted.
