Poor 1 pts	Character descriptions are incomplete, or confusing.	Product is not assembled, but left in packet form.	Character drawings or collage (cut and paste pictures) are not complete.	Not an accurate portrayal of the character. May contain vague descriptive language, such as "nice", or "good". Not informative or specific.	Poor, unrefined quality of language. Appears to be a first draft.
Fair 2 pts	All sentence stems are complete.	Product is not neatly assembled. Pieces may be falling off.	Characters look similar, or are not accurately portrayed.	Some inaccurate information. The character is not recognizable through the description alone.	Basic language, no synonyms. However, clarity and understanding of the character is still apparent. This does not appear to be a first draft.
Good 3 pts	All sentence stems are complete and make sense.	Product is somewhat neatly assembled.	Characters are recognizable, but lack of personal touches makes the poster not stand out.	The character is recognizable through the written description. Somewhat specific details.	Some descriptive language, synonyms for "simple" words are clearly used here.
Excellent 5 pts	The description adds insight into the character, letting the reader see your understanding of the character through inferences you've made while reading.	Final product is neatly typed or handwritten. The overall product is neatly glued or bound together.	Characters and drawn or collaged in an interesting way. Similar to the way they described in the book.	The descriptions match the character named, including vocabulary used in class discussions. Informative and specific.	Insightful, descriptive language, that creates a picture of the character in the reader's mind.
