- You can earn homework passes by completing 6 consecutive homework assignments on time. Homework passes can be used to replace missing **homework** assignments (turned in when that assignment is due) or be turned in for extra credit added to your homework grade at the end of the semester.

- Test/quiz retakes can be done by filling out the proper form and following the instructions. **You can only retake a test/quiz if all homework from that material has been turned in.**

Test/quiz retakes must be completed within 7 school days of when the original test is returned.

- Cheating on any assignment will result in a zero. If that assignment is a test there is no retake.
- Tests and quizzes must be made up before/after school or during lunch, not during class time.
- Late work will receive reduced credit. Late work will not be accepted after the end of each card marking. Late homework will receive half credit. Other assignments will receive a 25% reduction.
- If you are NOT on audit **and** you've completed at least 80% of your homework throughout the semester (not including homework passes)
 - Your Final Exam grade can replace your lowest test grade.
 - Your final grade will be rounded to the nearest whole percent.

ATTENDANCE

You will be marked tardy if you are not in the room at the start time for class and doing the bellwork. Four tardies will be counted as one absence.

When a student has ten or more absences, excused or unexcused, in one semester they will be on audit and may receive reduced credit for the course in addition to other consequences.
