

Sec 6-1 Classifying Quadrilaterals

Quadrilateral: A polygon with four sides.

What are some name of Quadrilaterals that you know:

parallelogram
Rhombus
Trapezoid - Isosalastrap
Signare
Rectargle
Kite





Characteristics of Special Quadrilaterals

Parallelogram: both pairs of opposite sides are parallel

Rhombus: a Parallelogram with $4 \cong sides$

Rectangle: a Parallelogram with 4 right angles

Square: a Parallelogram with 4 ≅ sides and 4 right angles

Kite: a Quadrilateral with two pairs of adjacent sides that are congruent and no opposite sides congruent.

Trapezoid: a Quadrilateral with exactly one pair of parallel sides (bases)

Isosceles Trapezoid: a Trapezoid whose nonparallel sides

are congruent (legs)
