

Dear Parent(s),

In social studies second graders are learning about the three different kinds of communities. They are rural, urban and suburban communities. To enhance your child's learning and to help them better understand the differences and similarities of these three kinds of communities we have an at home project for your child to complete.

Your child is to design a poster about the three kinds of communities. Please use a standard size poster board for your child's project. The poster board can be any color. There are 20 points possible for this project as listed below. Your child's poster needs...

- 1. A creative title (that relates to 3 kinds of communities) (1 point)
- To be divided into 3 separate columns and have each column individually labeled. One column labeled rural, another column labeled urban, and the other column labeled suburban (3 points)
- 3. 5 (or more) picture examples for each kind of community. So that's 15 examples altogether, 5 for rural, 5 for urban, and 5 for suburban. These pictures can be real photographs, magazine pictures, printed pictures off the computer, etc... (5 points X 3 columns = 15 points)
- 4. To be colorful and attractive! Your child can be as creative as he or she wants such as using paint, glitter, stickers, or whatever else. Have fun with it! (1 point)
