

Word Wall Projects

- A. Visual Representation: Choose one of the words from today's selection. Draw a colored picture to represent its meaning. Write the word in soft pencil on the back. Be prepared to present it before the class.
(individual)
- B. Show the Word: Write and perform a one-minute skit that depicts or illustrates the meaning of a word from today's selection. The word should not be a part of the text. Be prepared to present it before the class.
(pairs)
- C. Poem/Jingle/Song: Write a verse that "jingles" with light, simple repetitions and obvious, easy rhythm. Choose a word, but do not actually use it in the verse. The listener should be able to guess it correctly. Write at least 10 lines and rehearse to perform it.
- i.e. I went to the market square,
Where all things seemed fair.
To purchase two bags of apples,
And make some tasty strudels.
After I offered a fair price,
The vendor gave advice:
No way, not now, not here.
But those strudels must appear!
So to the price I added more,
Now, my strudels are in store.
(individual)--"haggle"
