- A. Visual Representation: Choose one of the words from today's selection. Draw a colored picture to represent its meaning. Write the word in soft pencil on the back. Be prepared to present it before the class.
- B. Poem/Jingle/Song: Write a verse that "jingles" with light, simple repetitions and obvious, easy rhythm. Choose a word, but do not actually use it in the verse. The listener should be able to guess it correctly. Write at least 10 lines. Try to guess the word for this example:

At Market

i.e. I went to market square,
Where all things seemed fair.
To buy two bags of apples,
And make some tasty strudels.
After I offered a fair price,
The vendor gave advice:
No way, not now, not here!
But those strudels must appear!
To the price I added more,
Now, my strudels are in store.
