Lastly, my sister volunteers for worthy causes to improve others' lives. Last summer, she joined Habitat for Humanity and once a month works on a crew rebuilding dilapidated houses for the homeless. Additionally, she helps to raise money for Paws with a Cause, an organization dedicated to training service dogs. I could go on with more examples of how she lends a helping hand to her community.
