Feminine:	alta	altas

If an adjective ends with -e, it stays the same for males and females, but there is a singular and plural form.

If an adjective ends in a consonant, it stays the same for males and females, but there is a singular and plural form.

	Singular	Plural
	intelectual	intelectuales
