


DECIMALS: A number with one or more digits to the right of the decimal

point. Example: Here is the number "forty-five and six-tenths" written as a decimal number:



## ADDING AND SUBTRACTING FRACTIONS




\*STEP 1: ALWAYS LINE UP THE DECIMALS.


\*\*NOTE: IF THERE IS A WHOLE NUMBER WITHOUT A DECIMAL, PLACE DECIMAL AT THE END OF THE NUMBER AND ADD ZEROS TO FILL SPACES AS NECESSARY.

\*STEP 2: ADD OR SUBTRACXT YOUR COLUMNS AS YOU ALWAYS DO FROM RIGHT TO LEFT.

\*STEP 3: BRING YOUR DECIMAL STRAIGHT DOWN IN YOUR ANSWER.
