


**A Coordinate Plane is formed by a horizontal line (left/right), called the x-axis, and a vertical line (up/down), called the y-axis. The two axes intersect at a point called the origin.

**You can locate any point on the coordinate plane by an ordered pair (x,y) of numbers call the coordinates.

**It is made up of four Quadrants. They are always labeled with Roman Numerals I, II, III, IV.



<u>ALWAYS</u>

Locate the x
coordinate
(Go LEFT or
RIGHT) first
then locate
the y
coordinate
(Go UP or
DOWN).
