

Creating Picture Filled Letters using Fireworks


Today's Objectives:


By the end of the assignment:

- ✓ I CAN create picture filled letters using the mask function in Macromedia Fireworks.
- ✓ I CAN insert my image in Microsoft Word and explain why I used each image
 - 1. Open a new Fireworks document Dimensions: W 800 H 600 Black background
 - 2. Pick one of the following words: STRONG, FAMILY, POWER, FRIENDS LOVING, PRIDE, MEMORY
 - 3. Add a text box, use Impact style font and enter the font size as at least 300 pt. The font color must be white or the mask will not work
 - 4. Add images to the canvas to cover each of the letters. Once you have the images where you want them over the letters, you must change the layers to have the text on top of the images.
 - 5. Once the images are aligned properly; Select all layers then, from the menu bar click on Modify>Mask>Group as Mask to see images fill the letters









- 7. Modify the canvas color to a color that has the most impact with your Bevel images and fit canvas so your image is the size of the word
- 8. Save as ### last name, first nameMask
