We are thrilled to announce our spring production of **Disney's High School Musical**. Any student in grades K-8th is welcome to audition. Below, you will find information regarding what our production entails and what we expect from our production students. Please read carefully.

Who may audition?

All Dearborn Schools students 8th grade and under are invited to audition. No previous experience is necessary.

Where and when is the audition?

- Thursday, January 24, 2019 **Open Auditions 3PM-6PM**
 - Friday, January 25, 2019 **Callbacks (invite only) 3-5PM**
- at the Stout Middle School Auditorium, 18500 Oakwood Blvd. Dearborn, MI 48124-4096.

No appointment necessary. Open Call Auditions. There is NO PAY. Auditions may run late, be prepared to stay the whole time. Please bring a list of all potential conflicts including travel, etc.

YOU MAY ONLY AUDITION ONCE

Who are the directors?

Rashid Baydoun will be directing the theatrical production and Vanessa El-zein is the musical director.

What will the audition consist of?

The audition will consist of readings from a script and the singing of a song of the director's choice and a light dance if needed. Material is available for study before auditions.

What is the director looking for?

We are looking for energized, **RESPONSIBLE**, and committed performers.

When are the performances?

We will have 4 PERFORMANCES on the following dates: **Thursday, April 25, 7 pm; Friday, April 26, 7 pm; and two performances on Saturday, April 27, 2 pm and 6pm. Additional school shows are scheduled for Wednesday, April 24th, and school shows on April 29th & 30th**

NOTE: Actors with conflicts March 26th – April 24th will NOT BE CAST.

It is **IMPORTANT ALL CONFLICTS BE LISTED ON THE AUDITION FORM**. Most conflicts are able to be accommodated. However if an actor fails to list all conflicts and several arise during the rehearsal process causing the actor to miss rehearsals, the actor will have to be replaced.

What will be the rehearsal schedule?

Rehearsals will be scheduled after the auditions and after actor conflicts have been taken into account. Generally rehearsals will be a 2-3 times a week in the evenings starting around 3 pm and going no later than 8 pm. **Rehearsals will increase as the production dates near.** Not every actor will be called to every rehearsal.
