

Test Re-take Contract

Re-take tests are not designed to be a replacement for having studied in the first place! If you frequently need to re-take tests we will need to meet and find ways for you to be more prepared to do well on tests.

Re-take procedure

- The original test must have corrections written out in complete sentence format.
- The original test must be signed by a parent or guardian.
- Signed and corrected tests must be turned in to the teacher **at least two days before** the re-take date.
- All assignments from the unit must be complete to be allowed to re-take a test.
- A parent or guardian must sign this form.
- Re-take forms must be turned in **no later than the day before** the test.
- You must follow through and plan to study much more seriously for the re-take. This may need to include time spent in tutoring after school.
- The re-take might be a completely different test or quiz on the same material and might be harder.
