$\frac{1}{2}$ t dried parsley flakes



16-oz pkg
egg noodles, cooked



slow cooker, sprayed
with cooking spray

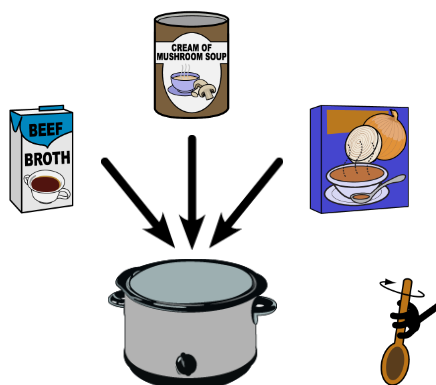

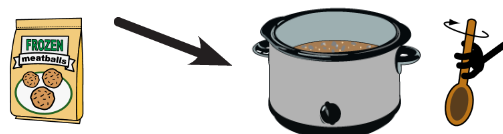

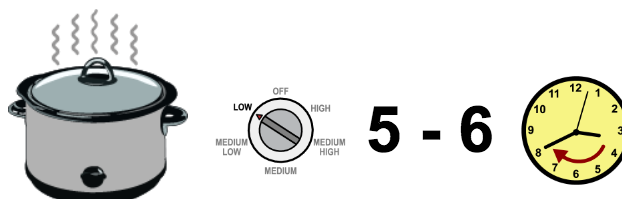
1. Put broth, canned soup and soup mix into slow cooker. Stir.

3. Cook on low 5 – 6 hours.

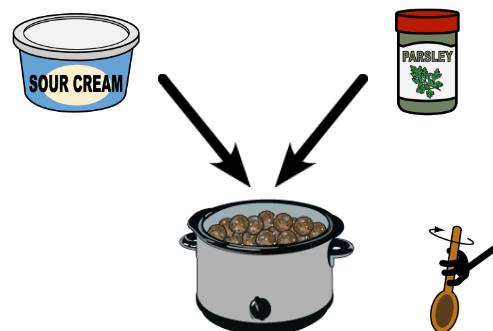

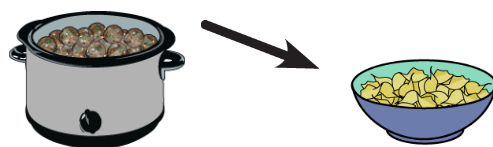
4. Put sour cream and parsley into slow cooker. Stir.
