The program offers the use of a digital camera (provided by AANM) and classroom instruction by professional photographers and teaching artists. In addition to digital camera, AANM is incorporating cell phone photography into the curriculum; cell phones are not mandatory. Students will develop skills in composition, color, lighting, image storytelling and media sharing. The curriculum includes visual presentations, photographic and writing assignments, discussions, critiques, guest artist visits and daily field trips around metro Detroit.
