Communites:

- are divided into places where people work, play, live, and shop.
 - People play at: <u>parks</u>, playgrounds, pools, etc.
 - People live in: <u>a house</u>, an apartment, etc.
- People take care of their communities by picking up trash.

Transportation:

- <u>Transportation means a way to</u> <u>move BOTH goods and people</u> <u>from one place to another.</u>
- People can move by water (<u>boats</u>, etc.), air (airplane), and land (car, <u>bus</u>, etc.).
- Goods can move by <u>truck</u>, boats, and airplanes, too.

Natural Characteristics:


- NOT made by humans.
- Examples: water, flower

Human Characteristics:

- Something made by a person.
- Examples: <u>school</u>, house, <u>fire</u>
 <u>station</u>

Maps:

- A drawing that shows what a place looks like from above.
- Have a map key.
 - The purpose of a map key is to show different places and things located on the map.
- Use North, South, East, and West



Consequences:

- Positive consequence: When something good happens because of a person or group of people.
 - o Example: Planting a tree.
- Negative consequence: When bad things happen as a result of an action a group or person takes.
 - Example: <u>Leaving your</u>
 <u>candy wrappers on the</u>
 <u>ground in the park</u>.

Regions:

- An area of land:
 - Small = community
 - Medium = state
 - Large = country
