1. How do we describe water as a liquid?*

properties: wet, clear, no smell, takes the shape of container

(examples: rivers, lakes, ponds, streams)

2. How do we describe water as a solid?*

properties: hard, frozen, cold, has its own shape, slippery, white

(examples: hail, icicles, ice cubes, icebergs, snow)

*For #1 and 2, it has been tricky for some students to remember which ones are properties (describe it) and which ones are examples.

3. Where do we get fresh water from?**

lakes, rivers, ponds, streams, underground, rain

** (It is important that students do not say ocean or sea for this question since they are full of salt)

4. How do we use water?

cleaning, cooking, water plants, create electricity, drink, shower, playing (sprinklers, water slides, ice skating), swimming, transportation, farming (water crops, feed animals)
