Landforms

- a natural feature of the Earth's surface
- made by nature
- Landforms to know, be able to describe, and identify:
 - hill - land that rises up but is not as high as a mountain
 - island - land that is surrounded by water
 - mountain - the highest kind of land and has a point, made of rock
 - plains - land that is mostly flat and grassy
 - plateau - land that rises up and has a flat top, made of rock
 - valley - low land between two mountains or hills

Bodies of Water

- water on the surface of the Earth
- Bodies of Water to know, be able to describe, and identify:
 - lake - a small body of water that has land around it
 - ocean - the largest body of water and its water is salty
 - river - a long body of water that flows through the land

How Water Moves

- Water is always flowing.
- Water flows from high places to low places.
- Water sometimes collects in a low spot in a land.
