Communities:

- are divided into places where people work, play, live, and shop.
 - People play at: parks, playgrounds, pools, etc.
 - People live in: a house, an apartment, etc.
- People take care of their communities by picking up trash.

Transportation:

- Transportation means a way to move BOTH goods and people from one place to another.
- People can move by water (boats, etc.), air (airplane), and land (car, bus, etc.).
- Goods can move by truck, boats, and airplanes, too.

Natural Characteristics:

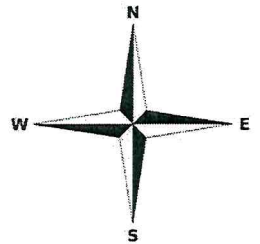
- NOT made by humans.
- Examples: water, flower

Human Characteristics:

- Something made by a person.
- Examples: school, house, fire station

Maps:

- A drawing that shows what a place looks like from above.
- Have a map key.
 - The purpose of a map key is to show different places and things located on the map.
- Use North, South, East, and West



Consequences:

- Positive consequence: When something good happens because of a person or group of people.
 - Example: Planting a tree.
- Negative consequence: When bad things happen as a result of an action a group or person takes.
 - Example: Leaving your candy wrappers on the ground in the park.

 - Medium = state
