
- "Antebellum" Before the Civil War

The American Civil War


- 1. South breaks away
 - a. States rights (to have slavery)
 - b. Economic decision
- 2. Five years of war
 - a. North (Union) had more people/soldiers - fighting to keep Union (US) together
 - b. South (Confederacy) had fewer people - fighting to retain (keep) independence
- 3. North Wins



Important Documents During/After Civil War

- Emancipation Proclamation Frees enslaved people in Confederacy
- 13th Amendment abolishes slavery
- 14th Amendment makes formerly enslaved people citizens
- 15th Amendment gives formerly enslaved men right to vote






Reconstruction
