Organization / Purpose: LEAD	<input type="radio"/> Lead is insufficient or lead is missing.	<input type="radio"/> Lead is weak and fails to hook the reader.	<input type="radio"/> Lead adequately hooks the reader but is not successful at holding the reader's interest.	<input type="radio"/> Lead effectively hooks the reader and brings him/her further into the essay.
Organization / Purpose: CLAIM	<input type="radio"/> Claim does not answer the question or respond to the prompt.	<input type="radio"/> Claim statement answers the question or responds to the prompt but no reasons are included.	<input type="radio"/> Claim statement answers the question or responds to the prompt but only includes 1 or 2 reasons.	<input type="radio"/> Claim statement answers the question or responds to the prompt and includes a minimum of 3 clear reasons.
Organization / Purpose: TRANSITION WORDS & PHRASES	<input type="radio"/> Transition words and/or phrases are not used and/or were used but make the reading more difficult.	<input type="radio"/> Transition words and/or phrases are used only words and/or are awkward in their use.	<input type="radio"/> Transition words and/or phrases are used but they don't consistently produce clear and coherent writing.	<input type="radio"/> Transition words and/or phrases are used to produce clear and coherent writing.
Organization / Purpose: COUNTER ARGUMENT (OPPOSING CLAIM or ALTERNATE CLAIM)	<input type="radio"/> Counter argument is not acknowledged.	<input type="radio"/> Counter argument is confusing.	<input type="radio"/> Counter argument is adequately acknowledged but no supporting evidence is provided.	<input type="radio"/> Counter argument is clearly acknowledged and one piece of supporting evidence is provided.
Organization / Purpose: CONCLUDING PARAGRAPH	<input type="radio"/> Concluding paragraph is missing.	<input type="radio"/> Concluding paragraph is weak and does not restate the claim.	<input type="radio"/> Concluding paragraph is adequate in restating the claim but does not summarize the reasons.	<input type="radio"/> Concluding paragraph is effective in restating the claim and summarizing the reasons.
