Math	<u>Module 1: Place Value and Decimal Fractions</u> Lesson 9 Add decimals using place value strategies and relate those strategies to a written method. Lesson 10 Subtract decimals using place value strategies and relate those strategies to a written method. Lesson 11 Multiply a decimal fraction by single-digit whole numbers, relate to a written method through application of the area model and place value understanding, and explain the reasoning used. Lesson 12 Multiply a decimal fraction by single-digit whole numbers, including using estimation to confirm the placement of the decimal point. Lesson 13 Divide decimals by single-digit whole numbers involving easily identifiable multiples using place value understanding and relate to a written method.
